

Antelope Hills Women's Golf Association  
General Meeting Minutes  
Thursday, July 31, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Heather Burnett, President, at 12:45 pm.

Board Members Present: Heather Burnett, Cookie Brewer, Jo Conn, Kathy Waldron and Jeannie Dew.  
Absent: Linda Amsbry and Lisa Prenticce. There were 31 members present including the executive board.

**SECRETARY REPORT:** Linda Amsbry (Absent) – Heather Burnett Reported:

- **The Minutes from the January 8, 2025, meeting were distributed. Heather Burnett asked if anyone had any changes or modifications. A Motion made taken to approve the Minutes as presented, Motion passed.**

**PRESIDENT'S REPORT:** Heather Burnett

- Heather Burnett discussed the start times that are currently in effect and the challenges we have experienced in April with the earlier start time, i.e., frost delay. She advised that the new start time will be 9:30 through the end of April.
- Heather Burnett gave an update on the "Busting Cancer Tournament" as follows:
  - Heather Burnett, Cookie Brewer, and Pattie Rice met with the Mile High Men's Golf Club to discuss the Tournament.
  - The Tournament will be held on Saturday, October 18, on the South Course.
  - There is a change in the format this year in that you will not be randomly paired with player of your opposite sex as previously done. This year a member of an Antelope Hills Golf Club will be able to pick any other player of opposite sex to play as a partner in the Tournament as long as both players have an active GHIN number. (The Antelope Hills Golf Clubs include: Antelope Hills WGA, Golfing Gals, Lady Twilighters, Mile High Men's Club or the Antelope Hills Men's Club.
  - The format will be 6, 6, 6 (6 holes Scramble, 6 holes Alternate Shot, 6 holes better ball)
  - There is a need for 7 raffle items to be donated from Antelope Hills WGA. Heather will be requesting rounds of golf for the raffle from golf courses who did not donate for our Invitational. Heather also asked if anyone wants to donate a basket for the raffle that they contact her directly with details.
  - New option in Tournament will be "Hit Inside the Pro" \$5 per par 3 on three of the par 3's.
  - Tee sponsorships will be available for \$250 each
  - Payment for this Tournament will be via check payable to "AHWGA" and mailed to Lisa Prentice (Treasurer) or placed in the locked drawer in the ladies room, or via Zelle (the Men's clubs requested Zelle availability for payments. Details to follow.)

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Lisa Prentice (absent) Heather Burnett reported the following:

- Second Quarter Financials distributed and attached hereto as Exhibit A. Ms. Burnett advised that the financial outlook for the second quarter is good. An expenditure was made to purchase a new printer.

**SWEEPS REPORT:** Jo Conn reported the following:

- Jo Conn advised Kathy Waldron has the second quarter payouts. If a player is not present Jo will put the envelopes with the payouts weekly for pick up by the player.
- The make-up date for the Medallion Tournament will be September 4 on the North Course.
- The Low Net Tournament was held today (July 31) with 11 players. There was some confusion as to whether or not the Low Net Tournament players would be included in the weekly game. Ms. Conn advised that last year they were not included and therefore were not included in the weekly game this year.
- The winner of the Low Net Tournament was Julie Weir, who was awarded \$20 prize money.

**HANDICAP/MEMBERSHIP:** Jeannie Dew reported the following:

- There are 109 members of Antelope Hills WGA. Ms. Dew announced the names of the new members since the last meeting.
- Ms. Dew reported that the Handicap Committee consists of her, Shary Koch and Lynn Getman. Ms. Dew reviewed the responsibilities of the Handicap Committee.
- Ms. Dew explained the “Soft Cap” and “Hard Cap” in the World Handicap System.
- Reminded everyone to post all scores when playing on non-league days and when played in accordance with the Rules of Golf. You can post a nine-hole score if the nine holes played are rated, i.e., front or back nine, and also if you play 10-18 holes, you need to post hole-by-hole.

**AGA/NAWGA LIASON REPORT:** Kathy Waldron reported the following:

- INTERCLUB –
  - The process is running smoothly. Ms. Waldron suggested that if you sign up for Interclub you need to get the checks submitted on time as there are a lot of deadlines to be met.
  - The notification emails through Golf Genius are working well
  - Explained that some clubs have limited the number of players
  - An email reminder is sent to those playing Interclub that also provides a list of the other Antelope Hills members who are playing so carpooling can be arranged. Ms. Waldron does not provide telephone numbers on this list, if you need to contact someone on the list you may get the contact information from the Antelope Hills WGA website
- NAWGA: Stroke Play tournament is scheduled for Talking Rock on August 5.
- AGA: Ms. Waldron reminded everyone that there are numerous events hosted by the AGA and all information is available on the AGA website.
- Ms. Waldron acknowledged that Antelope Hills has been supporting these events.

**COMMITTEE CHAIR UPDATES:**

1. **Tournaments:** Pattie Rice (absent) – Heather Burnett reported:

- The Member/Member Tournament was a success and the winners were Liz Simoneau and Sarah Cox.

- The Club Championship will be held August 14 and August 21. Sign up to play in the Club Championship in the ladies room, \$5.00 entry fee, place in envelope, write your name and “Club Championship” on the envelope and place in the locked drawer. The Club Championship is also flighted.
- If you are not playing the Club Championship and want to golf on those days you will sign up on Golf Genius to “Follow the Field”. There will be no game on those days.
- As a reminder, eligibility for tournaments: Must have played at least 10 times in league in the prior year and new members must play at least 3 times from January to the tournament to be eligible to play

2. **Rules:** Liz Simoneau reported the following:

- Pace of Play – we are doing better, but... She advised that you have to “read the room” so to say. In other words, know who you are playing with and whether it is safe to walk to your ball ahead or to the side of another player. She advised that you should be anticipating your next shot and get ready so when it is clear for you to play your shot there is no delay.
- A situation arose recently at another course that brought a rule into play wherein a ball struck from a bunker went over the green and landed in a water hazard on the other side of the green (yellow stake). The ball then had to go behind the water to hit over the water, keeping in line with the pin.
- A review was made of the Rules for Yellow vs. Red stakes/penalty areas.

3. **Team:** Heather Burnett reported the following:

- There are two rounds left (Antelope Hills and Wickenburg Ranch), both scheduled for September. Our Antelope Team is doing very well.
- The Team/Travel Shirts can be purchased online through Amazon:
  - Tanst Sky Brand (Blue White Leaf) or Viracy Brand (Blue Leaves)
  - Embroidery is at Creations in Thread (on Willow Creek Road next to the Safeway). The embroidery thread for the logo is “Fire Coral”

4. **Hole-in-One:** Karen Jennings reported the following:

- The last hole-in-one was February 2022, Robin Lundeen. Karen reported that this is the longest stretch without a hole-in-one in 10 years.
